Unforgettable Road Trips

Get to know Quebec in the most authentic way possible with a drive down one or several of the tourist routes and circuits that will have you following the river, zigzagging through the countryside and winding around lesser-known paths. The official routes, clearly identified with blue road signs, are designed to showcase the regions' cultural and natural treasures.





Whale Route

Discover the secrets of this circuit on the north shore of the St. Lawrence Estuary and Gulf that brings you to see the Mingan Archipelago, known for its sea-sculpted limestone monoliths and rich, diverse fauna and flora. Stretching across the regions of Manicouagan and Duplessis, this route is lined with shoreside attractions and impressive natural sites that travellers can explore on a sea expedition or whale-watching trip. Distance: 880 km/547 mi.

King's Road

This circuit goes through Lanaudière, Mauricie and Québec City and Area. Built in 1737, it was one of the first roads of its size in North America. It leads to picturesque old villages where you'll find many 300-year-old homes that are absolutely charming. Running on the north shore parallel to the majestic St. Lawrence River, this circuit with breathtaking views is part of the Route verte cycling network, making it safe for road trippers to bike on. Distance: 260 km/162 mi.



Navigators' Route

Follow the waves and explore the historical, cultural and maritime points of interest of the Centre-du-Québec, Chaudière-Appalaches and Bas-Saint-Laurent regions. Take this route to admire the river and marvel at the rich fauna and flora to discover at roadside stops. Climb to the top of an old lighthouse, set sail on the St. Lawrence to see the islands, go sea kayaking or take part in any number of other activities!
