

## Amsterdam & Region Day Ticket

The Amsterdam & Region Day Ticket entitles you to unlimited travel in Amsterdam and its whole region - day and night - on bus, tram and metro, for 24 hours. The day card is valid for 24 hours from first check in. With this ticket, you must always check in when boarding and check out when getting off the tram, bus, and metro.

### Connexxion bus 80

Route: Amsterdam Marnixstraat - Zandvoort Busstation

Bus 80 takes you to the beautiful old city centre of Haarlem. Enjoy the beautiful small streets and its picturesque houses.

This extraordinary confrontation of old masters is essential to the understanding of seventeenth-century art. Or visit the Dutch first and oldest museum, open for public purposes since 1784; Teylers Museum. A visit to Teylers Museum is like a voyage through time, a voyage of discovery in the world of art and science.

### Connexxion bus 172

Route: Amsterdam Centraal Station - Kudelstaart

Get on bus 172 and enjoy the Cobra Museum of Modern Art. It is an art destination unto itself. The museum combines a beautiful architecture with a permanent presentation of master pieces by the avant-garde artists of the Cobra movement.

Discover Flora Holland. The international trading platform for plants and flowers is a world in itself. You have to get up early to see this world-famous auction, but it's worth it!

## Zaanse Schans & Industrial Heritage

### Connexxion bus 391: Industrial Heritage Line

A ride on bus 391, the Industrial Heritage Line, is well worth your time.

First stop: NDSM terrain. This former shipyard on the IJ river is bursting with creative activity.

Second stop: Zaandam Center. The new renovated center of Zaandam is perfect for shopping and relaxing

Main stop: Zaanse Schans. Visit de Zaanse Schans with its old Dutch wooden houses and windmills. Here you'll discover how the Dutch people used to live and work in the 17th and 18th centuries.

## Waterland & Smalltown Harbours

EBS-bus 306 takes you (via Purmerend) to the Beemster. This reclaimed land is on the UNESCO's list of world heritage sites.

Smalltown Harbours Volendam, Edam, Marken, Hoorn

and Monnickendam can be easily visited taking one of the frequent bus lines of EBS. Hop on and see how time stood still for several centuries. EBS buses depart from the river side of Amsterdam Central station.

## Schiphol Amsterdam Express / Bus 197

Route: Schiphol Airport - Amsterdam Leidseplein/ Marnixstraat

Bus 197 will bring you directly to the center of Amsterdam. Close to the bus stops at Museumplein, Hobbemakade and Leidseplein, you'll find many hotels. Your discovery of exciting Amsterdam is about to start here.

Bus 197 departs in front of the main square at Schiphol Airport and departs at least every 15 minutes to Amsterdam. You can also take bus 197 for transfer from the city center back to Schiphol Airport.

## Amsterdam

### GVB tram 1

Route: Central Station - Osdorp De Aker

Tram 1 will bring you right through the centre of Amsterdam to the bustling Leidseplein. At the tram stop Dam you can find the Royal Palace and National Monument. At the Leidseplein stop you'll find cinema's, bars, restaurants and various theatres. Tram 1 departs in front of Central Station on the west side.

### GVB tram 9

Route: Central Station - Diemen

Tram 9 will bring you right through the centre of Amsterdam to the famous Rembrandtplein with cinemas, bars, restaurants and clubs. This line can also be used for the Hermitage Museum at tram stop Waterloooplein. Tram 9 also stops close to Artis Royal Zoo at stop Plantage Kerklaan. Tram 9 departs in front of Central Station on the east side.

### GVB tram 2 and 5

Route: Central Station - Nieuw Sloten / Binnenhof

Trams 2 and 5 will bring you right through the centre of Amsterdam to the Museum Quarter with Van Gogh museum, Rijksmuseum and Stedelijk museum. There are many hotels situated around Museumplein. Trams 2 and 5 depart in front of Central Station on the west side every 7.5 minutes.

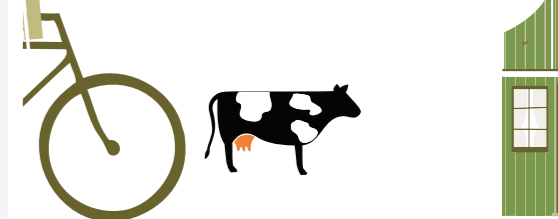
### GVB tram 13 and 17

Route: Central Station - Geuzenveld / Dijkgraafplein

Trams 13 and 17 will bring you to the Jordaan, undoubtedly the most sung about, described and romanced town district in Amsterdam. Started as a district for the poor, today it is a favourite place for students, artists and young professionals. Close to tram stop Westermarkt you'll find the Anne Frank House, where she wrote her world-famous diary while hiding in occupied Holland. Trams 13 and 17 depart in front of Central Station on the west side.

# Amsterdam & Region Public transport map 2013 / 2014

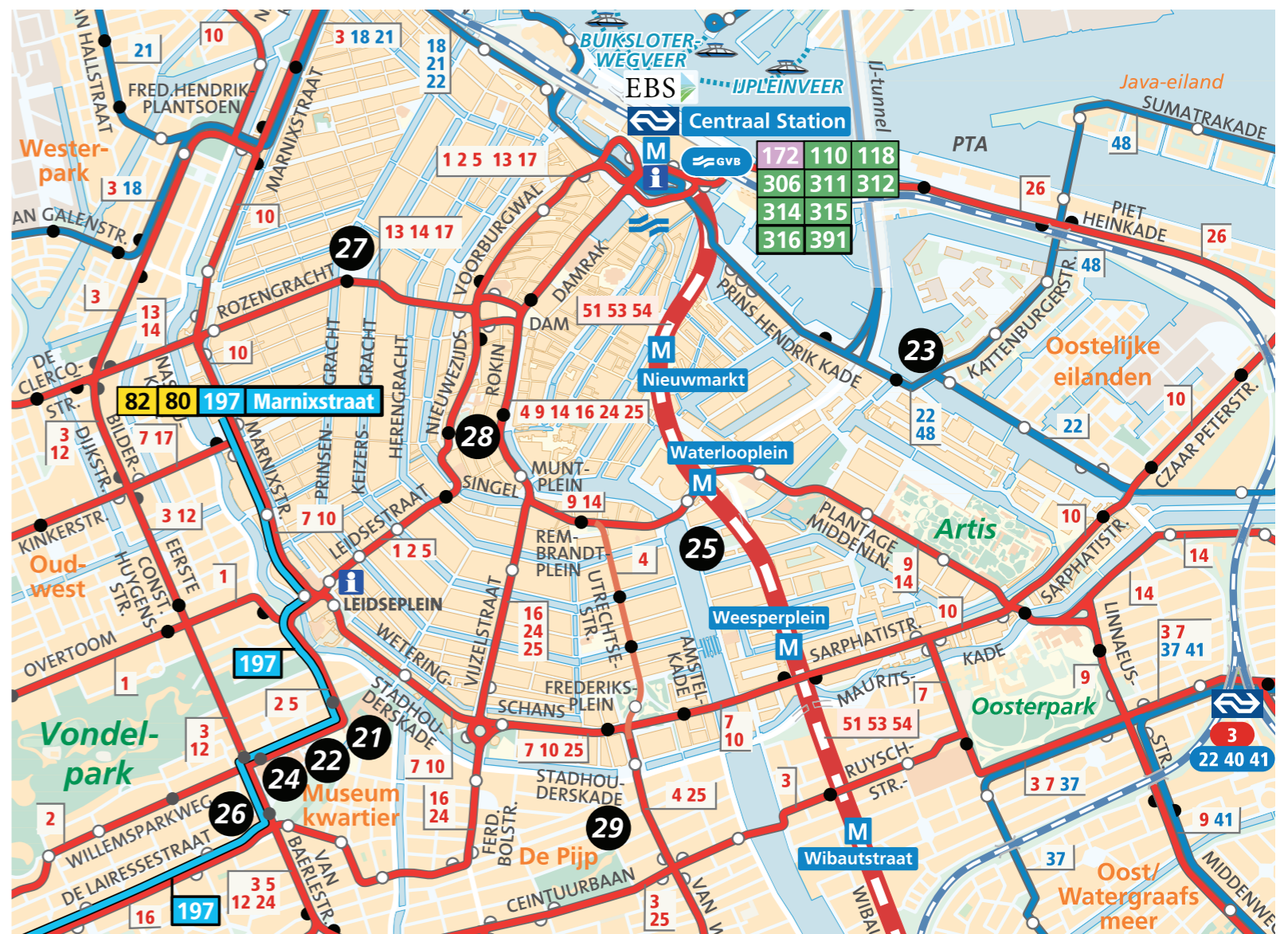
